
























#### RECENT TEMPERATURE TRENDS (1993-2022)










#### **Potting Mix Recipe**


- 3 parts compost fines
- 2 parts aged wood fines
- 1 part biochar

Amended with all purpose 8-2-4 fertilizer










	Germination

Biochar	75.5 %







- Multiple synergies between Biochar and Compost
- Compost as method of "charging" biochar.
- Biochar as a promising solution for the excess woody biomass
- There is a need for small (farm) scale biochar production technology
- It is much easier to have a hypothesis than to get the results that support it
